### The only working “Eucalyptus Stew Pot” in Victoria.

Located at Hard Hill Tourist Reserve, close to town in a natural bush setting is a working “Eucalyptus Stew Pot”. Eucalyptus is a natural Australia Product and was the first ever export out of Australia.

In the heart of Hard Hill Tourist Reserve visitors can watch a full demonstration on how to make pure “Blue Mallee Eucalyptus Oil” in a working Eucalyptus Stew Pot.

Visitors will:

- see the cutting of eucalyptus leaves
- be shown how the eucalyptus leaves are stacked into the stew pot
- view how the eucalyptus oil is processed
- learn how the eucalyptus oil is separated from the well
- smell the essences of raw eucalyptus oil.

Facilities at Hard Hill Tourist Reserve include:

- toilets
- picnic shelter and BBQ facility
- walking track around the reserve
- walk way to a historic gold mine
